A voice of the North Coast since 1999, Mr. Mayo and the Open Beaches and Trails Team, have been active advocates for commercial fishing, access and the resource community. The Open Beaches group has a demonstrated ability to pull together diverse interests to solve complex public policy issues, and are in a unique position to articulate the many voices, data and other public information, which the MLPA outreach program has been unable to tap into yet.

Open Beaches and Trails has successfully protected commercial beach fishing at Redwood National Park, a process which took over 8 yrs and presented very similar pitfalls in public process, legal issues, as has the MLPA, which required skilled coalition building. This ability has put Open Beaches and Trails in the forefront of public opinion in the North Coast Region MLPA process. It is our intent to use this unique perspective and coordination ability to bring together all the effected and concerned stakeholders not yet willing to actively participate in the MLPA process. It is critical to convince these stakeholders to participate in protecting their interests and fulfilling North Coast MLPA requirements.

Open Beaches and Trails has an incredibly diverse group working together, to meet the guidelines of the MLPA process, to provide the non consumptive and consumptive users with the best outcome possible.

There are data sets missing from the current process; inadequate data, only one example being the electronic data from Eco Trust. At the time of this submittal we are in another round of meetings with Eco Trust. We know many other sources of data have not be collected, which should be included.

Angry fishermen and angry community members does not a successful plan make, as witnessed as the latest South Coast MLPA / BRTF meeting. Without Mr. Mayo and the Open Beaches and Trails Team guidance to develop an absolute consensus for this community's 'a one plan option', that incident may seem like a tea party.

Our focus will be to:

- 1) Look closely at the salmonid population and restoration studies dating back to 1986,
- 2) Protecting the economic viability of the North Coast Harbors and Ports,
- 3) The safety of North Coast Fishermen,
- 4) Meeting the MLPA North Coast Region Guidelines,
- 5) Provide out reach to our areas distinct sub-regions and facilitate coordination between these sub-regional groups by,
- 6) Directing the passion in the North Coast community for protecting our rugged lifestyle and the opposition to the MLPA process into a cohesive position supporting 'a single plan proposal'.

We fully expect the MLPA staff to embrace this concept as we work together in this process.
