- 2) Has been involved for the last 48 years as a fishermen; processor; sailor; fish monger; fishery scientist; teacher of fishery management; (1959 - 1976): chair of PFMC Groundfish Management Plan; member of PFMC Dungeness Management Plan; (1977 - 1982); fishery research scientist and industry advisor Ano Nuevo to Oregon; (1978 - 1989): member of California's Master planning Team - MLPA; Manager; Gulf of the Farallones, Cordell Bank and Northern sector Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuaries; (1989-2004); advisor to Australia, New Zealand, France, Italy, Germany, Korea, Japan and China on fish and fishery issues; 1979-present): advisor on Ocean and Marine policy and planning National Park Service and National Marine Sanctuary Program; (2004-present): On UN committee to develop criteria for the Man in the Biosphere program on Marine Protected Areas (1995).
